NOTICE INVITING QUOTATION

Central Pension Accounting Office, Min. of Finance, Deptt of Expenditure invites sealed rates quotations for the Annual Maintenance Contract for 46 thin Client Machine from authorized /approved/eligible firms as per terms and conditions enclosed. The general scope of work includes:

- (a) Upkeep and maintenance of the Thin Client machine installed.
- (b) Repair to be carried out at the location of the equipment.
- (c) Stand-by arrangement to be made in case the equipment is to be taken to workshop for repairs.
- (d) Any other maintenance work to be undertaken related to the Thin Client machine

The interested parties may send their sealed quotations super scribed with 'Quotation for AMC of Thin Client machine etc'. and addressed to Pay & Accounts Officer, Central Pension Accounting Office, Trikoot-II, Bhikaji Cama Place, New Delhi by 3.00 P.M. on 27.7.2009. The quotations will be opened on the same day at 3.30 PM.

Late submission of quotations will not be accepted. Quotation by "Telex/Telegram/Fax/e-mail" will not be accepted. Quotations may be submitted by Registered Post, by Hand in Person or by Courier. However, any delay on this account shall not be accepted as a reason for exception. Quotation received after due date will not be accepted. The undersigned reserves the right to reduce or increase the number of items offered for maintenance contract during the currency of the AMC.

The Technical and financial terms and conditions of AMC shall be as follows:

(A) TECHNICAL

(i) The firm should be in existence for over 4 years in the trade with the maintenance business (service business turn over) of more than Rs.15 lakhs per annum during the last 2 years ending 31st March, 2009.

(ii) The firm must have expertise in on-site maintenance and repair of thin clients and its accessories.

(iii) The firm also must have expertise and experience in LAN troubleshooting. The bidder should have executed satisfactorily minimum two Annual Maintenance of more than seventy or hundred thin clients connected in LAN under Novell/Window NT environment.

(iv) The firm must be registered with Service Tax and Work Contract Tax (VAT) deptt.

(B) FINANCIAL

1. The rate may be quoted on comprehensive basis for the thin clients maintenance i.e. inclusive of the rates for replacements of parts and accessories of thin client in a separate sealed cover.

2. The others terms and condition for awarding the AMC shall be as below:

(i) The contract will be valid for a period of one year and extendable if services found to be satisfactory. The rates quoted will remain in force for the full period of contract. No demand for revision of rate on any account shall be entertained during the contract period.

(ii) The firm will prepare separate log books for each of the thin clients machines to be taken under the AMC and Preventive maintenance with virus detection and special cleaning of the thin clients etc. from outside with liquid cleaner and inside will be carried out on quarterly basis. A Preventive Maintenance Report from the user would be submitted to CPAO failing which an appropriate, penalty would be imposed. The quarterly payment will strictly be made on the basis of satisfactory report from the user.

(iii) The service engineers would take up any reported fault within 24 hours. As far as possible, the repairs would be carried out on-site itself. However, in case the equipment is taken to the workshop,, the firm would provide a stand-by for the same.

(iv) If any thin client is not repaired within forty eight hours, the firm will provide a stand by machine. If, however, the firm fails to carry out repairs /provide a stand –by PC/accessory within 2 days , to the satisfaction of the user, a penalty of Rs. 200 (Rupees two Hundred Only) per day or part thereof will be charged for delay beyond the two working days till such time the machines are repaired. .

(v) It may also be noted that in case of contractor backing out in mid term without any explicit consent of this department , he will be liable to recovery at higher rates, vis-à-vis, those contracted with its, which may have to be incurred by this Department on maintenance of machines for the balance period of contract through alternative means.

(vi) The above act of backing out would automatically debar the firm from any further dealing with this Ministry.

(vii) No advance payment in any case would be made. However, quarterly payment on pro rata basis on satisfactory rendering of service would be made which will be released to contractor on completion of the contract.

The rates quoted should be net and no discount, free services/offers quoted will be considered.

This tender is not transferable. CPAO reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tenders without assigning any reasons.
