OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Implementation of Government's decision on the recommendation of the Sixth Central Pay Commission - Revision of provisions regulating pension / gratuity / commutation of pension / family pension / disability pension / ex-gratia lump-sum compensation.

Please refer to the OM No. 38/37/08-P&PW(A) dated 2nd September, 2008 where by the pensions of the Post 2006 retirees have been revised. The same is available at <http://pensionersportal.com/>. The post 2006 retiree cases are being received in CPAO and a revised authority is being issued to banks. You may revise the cases on the receipt of revised authority from CAPO. In this regard we would like to reiterate to DPPW orders as already provided at <http://pensionersportal.gov.in/sixthCPC/paycommersol.pdf> that only 40% of the arrears are to be paid in the financial year 2008-09.

Kindly ensure that the due & drawn statement for post 2006 pensioners is also provided to the pensioners by the paying branch as is being provided to the pre-2006 pensioners. In post 2006 cases payment may be made within 3 working days of the receipt of the authority by the bank. The pensioner slip and endorsement of the PPO (pensioner's half) may be made by the paying branch.

O/o CGA vide its OM No. 1(7) (1)/2008/T.A. (pt. file)363 dated 01.11.2008 that with the view to facilitating speedy settlement of pension, the BSR code relevant to the particular paying branch should be mentioned in the PPOs in future. In case all your paying branches authorised for pension is not available in the bank directory of CPAO (available at <http://www.cpao.nic.in/>) the same should be provided by the banks urgently. You may also provide the branchwise telephone directory of your bank in a softcopy at the e-mail address ca-cpao@nic.in.

To facilitate preparation of annexure-III which is to be prepared by bank and sent to CPAO and PAO separately a facility has been created in the cpao website mentioned above where data entry of all the cases can be done and an output in the form of annexure-III as well as report in an Excel Sheet can be generated.

O/o the CGA has also issued revised format of authority as well as PPO which is available in their website <http://cga.nic.in/>. under the head "Important order and circulars" for your perusal and necessary action.

Your bank may take all necessary steps to disseminate this end earlier orders of GOI to each pension paying branch to enable them and equip them to provide the best services to pensioners.
